History of Kaliabor College of Education

Kaliabor College of Education was established in 1992 located at Kuwaritol, Kaliabor Sub-Division in the district of Nagaon (Assam). The College has its own land (10 Bighas) i.e 3.3 Acres with RCC buildings, G2 buildings, 02 Assam Type buildings with spacious Auditorium hall and Seminar Hall. It has also obtained recognition from National Council for Teachers Education (NCTE) for B.Ed. (Intake=100) and D.El.Ed (Intake=50) courses and has been permanently affiliated to Gauhati University. The College is also running B.A Course (FYUGP) Four Year Degree Course under Gauhati University from the session 2021-2022 with Major in Education and other Minor Subjects. The College has sufficient Infrastructural and Institutional facilities with well arranged Library, Classrooms, Office Room, Staff Rooms, Student's Reading Room as per UGC/NCTE Norms, Psychological Laboratory , ICT/ Computer Room with 20 (Twenty) sets of Computers, Outdoor/Indoor Games Facilities, Sanitary Arrangements are available in the College Campus. The College has obtained Government Concurrence by the Govt. of Assam and it has been maintaining proper records such as Admission Forms, Admission register, Fee Register, Students/ Faculties/Non-Teaching Staffs Attendance Register, Tutorial Records, Cash Book, Stock Register, Receipt Books and Ledger Books. The College has Rs. 24, 00,000 (Rupees 24 Lacks Only) Fixed Deposits by means of Reserve Fund and Endowment Fund. Governing Body of Kaliabor College of Education is the Apex Body which is a Non-Profit registered under the Societies Registration Act xxi of 1860, Gauhati, Assam bearing Registration Number 297/02887/NOPAN/12/2019 which is running the College since the Commencement of the Society. The institution is situated on the bank of the river Kollong with beautiful sights and scenes and attached to the NH-127 having its own street. The College is well connected by Bus, Rail and Air.

2. Admission Criteria

Eligibility for B.Ed.

A Graduation 10+2+3 pattern of Gauhati University or any other university recognized by U.G.C. may be admitted to the B.Ed.Course as per N.C.T.E. norms.The admission criterion is 50% of marks in aggregate for general students and 45% of marks aggregate for **SC/ST/OBC/MOBC** only.

Procedure of Admission:

1. Admission to the college is strictly on merit basis, and the admission procedure is formulated by Governing Body, Keeping in view the guidelines issued by the University from time to time. The decision of the college authority would be final in this regard.
2. Candidates seeking admission in to the B.Ed.Course have to passed the B.Ed.Common entrance test (GUBEDCET) conducted by the Gauhati University.
4. The prescribed application forms duly filled in by candidates have to be submitted on or before the last date as notified in the Notice Board /website.
5. Students must enclose the following documents along with the admission form-
 - I. Self-attested photocopies of each of the documents- all marks sheets from H.S.L. C onwards , H.S.L.C. or equivalent certificate, Degree/P.G. certificate, Registration certificate of G.U., Caste certificate ,if any Migration Certificate (in case of candidates from any university other than GU.
 - II. College dues as per notification at the college Notice Board will have to be paid at the time of admission. Fees once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.

N.B.: *Original documents must be produced at the time of admission.*

4. Rules and regulations

4.1 Attendance

It is obligatory on the students to attend all classes regularly and punctually. Willful absence from the Classroom lectures will be treated as serious breach of college discipline. As a rule, a student is required to attend at least 75% of the lectures delivered in each subject.

4.2 Library Rules

Library cards are issued to each student after depositing library caution money of Rs 500 (refundable) as security money for borrowing books from the library. Computers and Internet facilities are available in College library.

4.3 Examination Rules:

Apart from the final examination conducted by G.U., class test, Unit test, terminal examination and test examination are held in the college according the college academic calendar, which will be given to the trainee on the first day of the session.

It is obligatory for all the students to appear in all the examination.

- Rules of Examination Results.
 - a) Marks of external and internal examination will not be shown separately
 - b) A candidate, in order to pass, must obtain at least 40% marks in aggregate.
 - c) A candidate will have to secure at least 40% marks in individual paper.
 - d) A candidate who secure below 40% in one individual paper but if he/she secure aggregate 40% will be allowed to reappear in the examination as a back paper.
 - e) Candidate securing at least 60% marks shall be declared to have obtained a first Class.
 - f) Candidate securing marks between 560 to 839 (both included) shall be declared to have obtained a second Class.
 - g) A candidate who fails to pass or present himself for the B.Ed. Examination shall not be entitled to claim a refund of the examination fee nor will such fee be carried over for subsequent examination.
 - h) If a student after completion of a regular B.Ed. course and after having obtained his/her admit card does not appear in the B.Ed. final examination for some unavoidable reason he/she may appear in the next subsequent examination as a non-collegiate and will be required to pay the prescribed fees.-
 - If a candidate
 1. Fails in theory part only.
 2. Fails in practical part only.
 3. Fails to secure pass marks in assignment paper(s)

But otherwise eligible to pass the B.Ed. examination will be given a chance to re-appear or submit the report –within two years to clear his/her paper(s)/ Practical/ report/assignment. But the candidate must take casual admission(s) for the years(s) and pay all the prescribed fee for the subsequent examination(s). If a candidate fails in only one theory paper in the third year from the year of his/ her admission he/she shall have a chance to re-appear in that paper only in the immediate next year.

- The college authority will conduct Sessional test apart from the Final Examination as per guideline of G.U. Monthly tests are also held to assess the students' gradual progress.
- The Internal Assessment is the basis of the students' performance in the sessional work.
- The Final Practice Teaching, Practical Examination for ICT, Art & Drama ,Internship examination conducted by Gauhati University. The college will follow the rules and regulation of G.U./ SCERT in matters of examination

5.Facilities :

5.1 Library

The College has a well-equipped library with a good number of textbooks as well as reference books on all subjects. There is a fairly good collection no of books for all subjects as per requirement. The library also subscribes to dailies, weeklies, periodicals and journals. The college has provision of reading room with adequate facilities.

5.2 Laboratory:

The college has a well-equipped ICT Laboratory having adequate number of computers. The ICT Laboratory has provision of Internet facility .The college has also provisions of psychological laboratory with adequate apparatus and a well-equipped science and mathematics laboratory. The college has well equipped Science laboratory for science method.

5.3 Teaching Staff:

The college has the requisite number of qualified and experienced teachers as per N.C.T.E. and UGC norms.

5.4 Identity Card:

An Identity card issued to every trainee. Those who have lost their identity card may get duplicate identity card by applying to the authority along with a stamp size photo and prescribed fee .

6. Special features:

1. The college organized seminars and workshops from time to time.
2. Provision of concession offers for merit or poor students (BPL category)
3. The College has a provision of well-equipped Art and Craft room.
4. Provision of individual guidance by the teacher.

6.1 Co-Curricular Activities:

To promote a healthy academic life among the trainees and to provide opportunities for their all-round development, various co-curricular activities are organized by the college with the co-operation of the trainees. Trainees' regular participation in those activities is compulsory.

6.2 Practice Teaching

1. Every B.Ed 1st Year trainee shall do practice teaching in the method papers taken up by him/her in the selected schools under provision.
2. The trainees will have to maintain a diary of their day-to-day progress of teaching in practice teaching classes and get it counter signed by the Head of the school where they have done their practice teaching.
3. One lesson shall be assessed by the external examiner in final practice teaching.

6.3 Internship:

There shall be provision of internship for B.Ed. Trainees. The B.Ed. Second Year trainees have to do internship for a period of 4 months at secondary schools as per NCTE Regulation 2014 and G.U.B.Ed. Syllabus .

ATTENDANCE AND PERIODICAL EXAMINATION :

- Student must be regular in attending in classes including Practical and internship 75% attendance in each subject and 80% attendance in seminars, group discussion, tutorials, Practice teaching, Craft practical, demonstration etc. is compulsory for appearing in the university examination.
- Regular monthly and terminal examination shall be conducted throughout the B.Ed. course as per Academic Calendar of the College.

- In case of absence from any examination without any reasonable ground which is not satisfactory to the college administration the students shall not be allowed to appear in the university examination of B.Ed.

MISCONDUCT AND INDISCIPLINARY ACTS

- Damaging the College property inside or outside the college.
- Use of abusive slogans.
- Ragging.
- Disrespectful behaviour with elders.
- Misbehaviour with female students.
- Eve Teasing.
- Violating the dress code.
- Using alcoholic or Narcotic drugs.

- Disruption of teaching, study, Examination or administrative works, co-curricular activities or residential life of the members of the college.

PENALTIES

- Written warning and information to parents will be given.
- Fine to be determined by the Principal/Authority of the College/ Management.
- Rejection of admission /enrolled from the admission register.

LIBRARY RULES

A library is meant to satisfy the thirst for knowledge. To enable this task certain rules are required to be followed for conduct of discipline for benefit to all. These rules will help in creating necessary condition under which the library in the modern sense can be established and maintained adequately to serve the needs of users. The rules are appended below...

- (i). Students must bring library card complete with photo identification duly attested by librarian and principal with them.
- (ii). The books will be issued only when the library card is produced before the librarian.
- (iii). Books can be issued only on personal card.
- (iv). Student must maintained pin drop silence in the library.
- (v). Books will be issued only for 15 days. After 15 days students charged @ 5 Rupees per day as a late fine.
- (vi). When the book issued to the borrower is damaged or destroyed he/she will have to pay the fine.
- (vii). Students are strictly prohibited to bring the personal books and their belongings.
- (viii). If a student wants to keep the book for more than 15 days, the book will be re-issued to him/ her on the decision of librarian.

(ix). If the library card is lost by the student he/she will have to pay Rs. 25 for getting duplicate library card.

MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION

The medium of instruction of the College is English.

IDENTITY CARD

The Identity Card is issued to every trainee. The card should be kept by the trainee till the completion of the course. No renewal is required during the course of study. If the original card is lost, a duplicate can be obtained from the College on payment of Rs. 50/-

PROJECT WORK

Project work is carried out by every trainee during the course since it demonstrates the capability of the trainees for some original approach in the application of theoretical knowledge gained from the course. The project work is finalized in consultation with the Department concerned. Several project works may be carried out during the course according to the norms of the Gauhati University and NCTE.

STUDENTS DISCIPLINE

Great emphasis is laid on discipline and character building. Trainees are expected to maintain a high standard of discipline. The Principal of the College reserves the right to remove from the names of trainees for unsatisfactory conduct.

ANNUAL MAGAZINE

The college encourages to publish its annual Magazine every year in order to develop the creativity and literary talents of the trainees.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Through co-curricular activities in the College the trainees are taught to be an ideal leader in the field of education.

PERSONAL CONTACT CLASSES

Personal contact seminars are arranged by the College for the benefit of the trainees. Separate communication is made to students regarding the contact seminar classes.

Payment of Fees

The prescribed Admission, Registration, Migration and Examination fee etc. are to be paid by the

candidates through Bank Payment. No cash payment is accepted. The fee once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.

Registration and Migration

Every admitted candidate from other University shall have to register his/her name in G.U. He /She must produce Migration certificate within one month from the date of admission.

Attendance

A student shall be eligible for End-Semester or Annual Examination if he/she has attended not less than 75% of the lectures delivered in theory including seminars/Workshops etc. in each course and 80% of the practice teaching/internship/school based activities/field work etc.

Uniform/Dress Code

All trainees will wear uniform as prescribed by the college authority.

Examination

Apart from the co-curricular activities and the final examination conducted by G.U. and SCERT, Assam, Class Test, Unit Test, Sessional Test, Terminal Examination and the Test Examination are held in the college according to the academic calendar strictly observing the guidelines of the competent authorities. It is compulsory for all the students to appear in all the examinations.

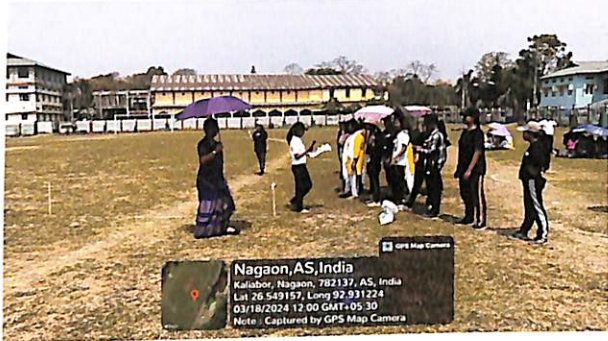
