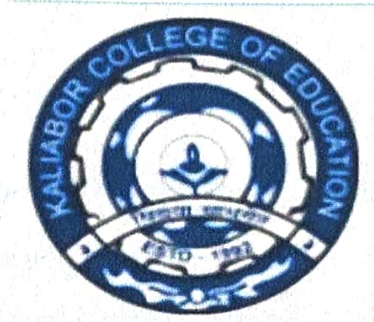

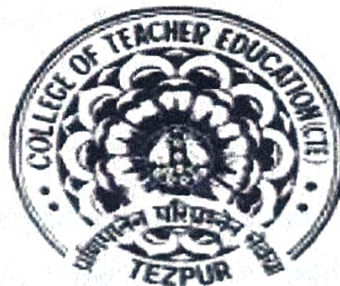

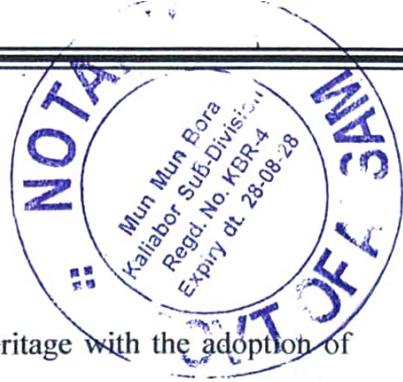
4. Enhancing Cultural Collaboration:
